Our statement of general policy is:

- To comply with statutory requirements and codes of practice under the Health & Safety at work Act 1974
- To ensure that management and employees at all levels understand their individual responsibility's related to health and safety
- To provide adequate control of the health and safety risks arising from our work activities,
- To consult with our employees on matters affecting their health and safety
- To provide and maintain safe plant and equipment
- To ensure safe handling and use of substances, provide up to date information and monitor skills
- To provide information, instruction and supervision for employees
- To ensure all employees are competent to do their tasks and to give them adequate training.
- To prevent accidents resulting in personal injury and property damage.
- To prevent accidents and cases of work related ill health.
- To maintain safe and healthy working conditions.
- To undertake regular fire evacuation drills and provide adequate fire protection equipment.
- To safeguard our employees by providing appropriate security measures.
- To review and revise this policy as necessary at regular intervals.
